Once there, put your mouse over "Current Residents" then click "Payments" on the drop down menu. Complete all information noted as "required". Once completed, click "Finalize and Process Order". If done correctly, you will then see a message that your payment has been accepted.

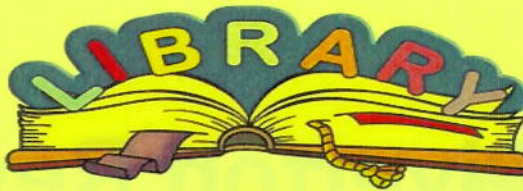
Knitting/Crocheting anyone?
