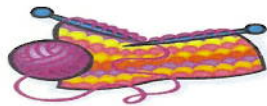
## Bingo with a Pina Colada

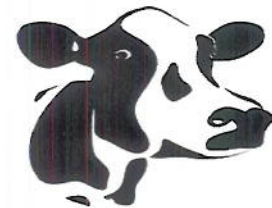
### New Receptacle
