North Elevator may be back in service on Tuesday, Jan. 4. "Refurbishment of the DC Generator has been accomplished. Installation is scheduled for next Tuesday". Good news.

I then explained that I would like to get an idea of what Ken considers to be the accomplishments of 2021 and his expectations and goals for 2022.

Ken said that a big success for the year was the installation of the **electric rear Lobby door**. "It is an amazing piece of equipment and I love having it".

Investments made for **Infrastructure** work on our aging building has proved to be wise and work has been progressing nicely. Infrastructure work will be ongoing.

"**Communications** have also been improved", both internal communicating with the staff and instant communication with residents, if need be, through our new system the 'One Call Network'. "We want residents to know what is going on".

Proof of 2021 Income

Under Florida law, to be eligible for real estate tax exemptions, we must have proof of all residents' income. We must collect all of your income for the year of 2021 and then complete an application that **must** be submitted to the Property Appraiser's Office on or before March 1, 2022. As you begin receiving your 1099's in the mail, please make haste in submitting this information to us. We need your help to obtain this exemption.
